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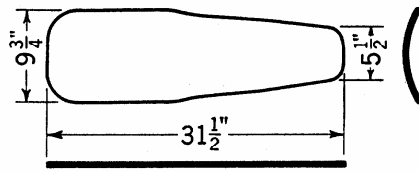
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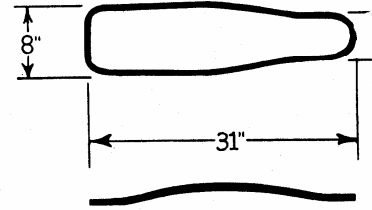
Side and Back Presses



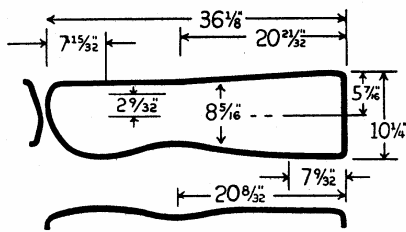
MODEL U-3 Used in conjunction with front offpressing. Will finish sides and backs of men's sack coats without destroying the chest expression as often happens with wider machines. Has a flat pressing surface.



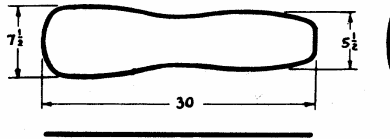
MODEL U-4 This model is used for the same operation as the U-3. Head and buck, which are oval, are desired by some manufacturers because of the contour of the buck.



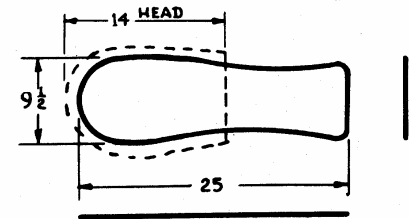
MODEL U-5 The head and buck of this model are designed as a back pressing machine. They have a special contour and is especially desirable for ladies' shape coats. Also used for children's jackets.



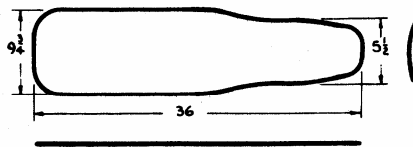
MODEL U-6 (Right and Left): For pressing back seams and shoulder blades on young men's coats. It will press the shape needed for the shoulder blade as well as the curvature between the shoulder and waist.



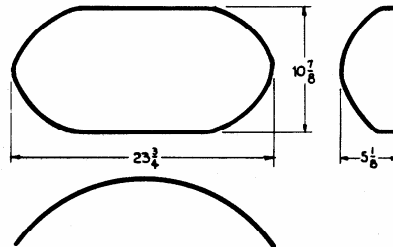
MODEL U-7 This model is especially adapted for pressing sides and backs of ladies' tailored suitcoats.



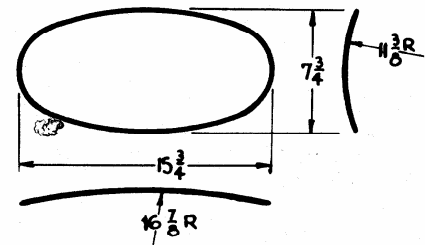
MODEL U-26 (Right and Left) Uniformly presses the tapes at front and back of armhole before shoulder is joined. Unpresses the blade and chest; also presses the canvas lining after shoulder is joined and shoulder pad sewn in.



MODEL U-36 Designed for all around offpressing of side seams and backs of sack coats. It is especially adapted for use on the longer length men's sack coat.



MODEL H-2 Especially designed to form the modern hip formation which is so widely used by ladies' suit manufacturers. It is used to offpress the hip section after the hip canvas is basted to the coat, or for shaping the canvas separately.



MODEL M-7 Shorter and narrower than older mushroom designs, for pressing ladies' form fitting woolen dresses, blouses and tailored jackets with ease and speed. Used for shaping upper back portion and the hip, as well as finishing the bottom of ladies' jackets.

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
